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This page is already configured to A4 paper size which is (8.27") wide and (11.69") long. The margins are all equal to (1"). Your paper must be in two column format with a space of (0.29") between columns and a width of (2.99") for each column.

All paragraphs must be justified with font type Times New Roman. Recommended font sizes are shown in Table 1.

### 2.1 FIGURES AND TABLES

Figures and tables must be centered in the column. Large figures and tables may span across both columns. Any table or figure that takes up more than 1 column width must be positioned either at the top or at the bottom of the page.




Fig. 1. A sample graph caption with

All figures resolution must be with an adequate resolution for printing (not less than 300 dpi). Figures and tables numbering must be using Arabic numerals. Captions with figure numbers must be placed after their associated figures, as shown in Fig. 1.

### 3. SECTIONS HEADINGS




Fig.2. Styles box

All levels of section headings have bold face font. First level section heading is capitalized, numbered and centred. The acknowledgment, conclusion, nomenclature and references sections have the same formatting except that they are not numbered. For the second level section heading it must contain numbering sequence ( 1.1 1.2 1.3 ), left aligned and small caps. For the headings of the third level the sequence numbering is also continued (1.1.1 1.1.2), with the same formatting except it is regular font. The three heading formats are listed in the styles box as you can notice in Fig. 2.

### 2.2 OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

The manuscript title, authors, affiliations and abstract must be in single-column format and must be centered. The rest of the manuscript must be in two column format. Page numbers, headers and footers must not be modified.
